Terms of Reference

Role	The Third Sector Working Group will be an independent Group within the structure of the Third Sector Forum comprised of third sector managers/volunteers whose organisations are funded by statutory agencies and/or who have formal arrangements eg SLA, are commissioned and/or have paid staff. The Group will be an operational forum for the receipt and exchange of information and peer support and act as a link between special interest groups and the Third Sector Forum.
Remit	 to provide an opportunity for information and knowledge exchange to receive information/training on operational issues such as funding, training, etc to receive/report on relevant issues raised by/from Third Sector Forum Special Interest Groups to advise the Third Sector Forum on key issues as appropriate to enable peer support to make a commitment to work together and to attend as regularly as other duties permit to contribute items to the agenda to meet monthly on the last Thursday of each month with further meetings called as required to circulate approved notes within their organisations, to the VAO Board and the Third Sector Forum
Membership	 Members will be representatives of organisations that are funded by statutory agencies and/or who have formal arrangements eg SLA, are commissioned, have paid staff. Representatives of statutory and other organisations may be invited to attend when particular items on the agenda warrant their attendance. The VAO Chief Executive will act as chairperson
Other	VAO will provide meeting and administrative services
