Legislation and guidance

Changes to charity law

OSCR Scottish Charity Regulator Legislation was laid in the Scottish Parliament last month to bring into effect some of the changes contained in the Charities (Regulation and Administration) (Scotland) Act 2023. These changes will take effect on 1 April 2024. OSCR has been working hard to make sure charities and the public get maximum benefit from the improvements these changes will bring.

While there is no immediate action required on the part of charities or charity trustees, OSCR want to make sure that the sector and those who advise it know what changes are coming up.
